PAD Paris, short for Pavilion of Art and Design, is back. One of the most anticipated events in the art and design calendar, PAD is renowned for its fusion of art, design and craftsmanship and a huge draw seasoned collectors and enthusiasts alike.

The 26th edition, which runs 3-7 April, offers a unique platform in the French capital to converge and celebrate the creativity on display from across the globe. From furniture and decorative objects to fine art and jewelry, the curated selection of pieces span various styles, periods and mediums.

Which galleries to visit at PAD Paris 2024?

Maison Parisienne

Paris-based Maison Parisienne is known for its pick of the best of contemporary French craftsmanship and high-end furniture design.

For this year's PAD, which marks 15 years of the gallery, it will be exhibiting a selection of original works by its *artistes de la matière*. A wall of mirrors created by 15 artists each in their preferred medium will be installed and *Décade*, Simone Pheulpin's historical mural work, will be unveiled for the first time.
